Debonne Car Show Registration Guidelines

- 1. Fill out registration car by us in magic marker and write big and correct so the judges can read the cards. Ask the person registering his name (and how to spell it if you don't know), the make of the car being registered, the year, and the class number (which are posted on the table).
- 2.Charge is \$5.00 per vehicle (not per person). Explain that <u>if the vehicle is less than 25</u> <u>years old, it will NOT be judged and they don't have to pay</u>. If they insist on paying, they will get a dash plaque and a door prize ticket. They do not get a door prize ticket or dash plaque if they don't pay. Please put a "DNJ" where there would be a class.
- 3. Give a door prize ticket to each person registering, keep the matching ticket and put it in the can. Tell the person that we will be calling ticket numbers every <u>15 minutes</u> <u>starting at 12:00 NOON</u>, and they will be posted on the board on the table. When we get a winning ticket we will erase the number. The prizes are displayed on table.
- 4. Tell the driver if he wants their vehicle judged, they have to have their hood open.
- 5. Give each driver a dash plaque and if we run out, get their name and address so Beth can mail them one.
- 6.Trophies are usually given out around 4:30 PM, we will notify you if this changes. We will begin to move the trophies down to the bandstand around 4:00 PM.
- 7. The cut off time for registering to be judged will be 2:00 PM. This is posted on the flyer.
