Dave and Shirley Payne have the next meeting, Saturday, February 14th . See below for details.

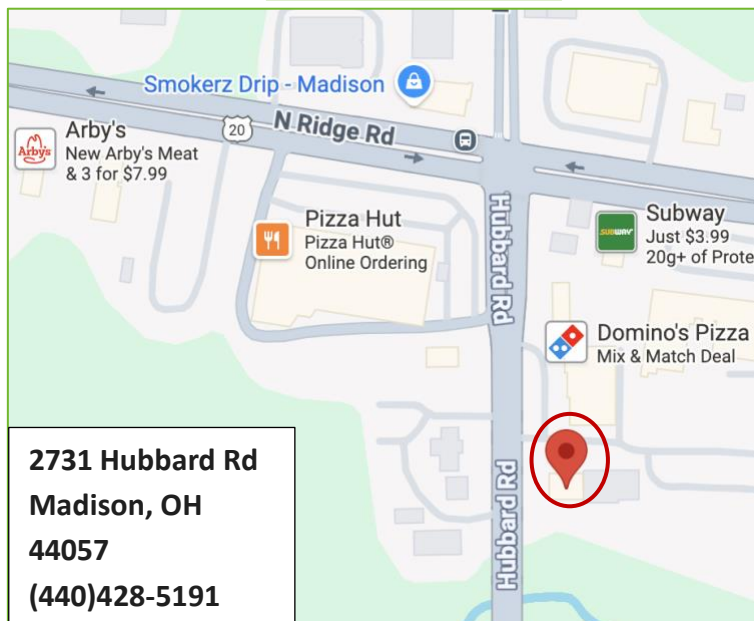
