Two notable birthdays in July are Nancy Reagan and Tom Hanks. Nancy (1921-2016) was born in New York City. She was a movie actress before marrying Ronald Reagan in 1952. They had 2 children together. She was best known as the First Lady of California and of the United States when Ronald became the 40th President (1981-1989). She championed the 'Just Say No' campaign to combat the war on drugs. She had a strong influence on her husband and played a role in a few of his personnel and diplomatic decisions. She gained high approval ratings in later life for her devotion to Ronald in his final illness.

Tom Hanks (1956–current) is an American actor and filmmaker whose 'everyman' charm and versatility have made him one of the most beloved cultural icons. A two-time consecutive Best Actor Oscar winner for Philadelphia (1993) and Forrest Gump (1994), Hanks starred in classics like Saving Private Ryan, Cast Away, Apollo 13 and voiced Woody in the Toy Story franchise, while also directing, producing, and earning honors like the Presidential Medal of Freedom. Tom seems like he is accessible and can relate to everyday life while bringing out the best in the characters he plays. I admire him for his consistent portrayal of roles that capture our hearts.

I would like to introduce Chet Sutherland to the Club. He is from Canton, OH. He works at Nickels Bakery in Navarre and really enjoys vintage cars but does not own any. He has an interest in historical events and sports. We are enjoying getting to know each other and I hope he will become a member of the club.

REGISTRATION
